What kinds of animals need care?

- Cats with medical conditions or injuries
- Special needs cats

Can I foster if I have pets of my own?

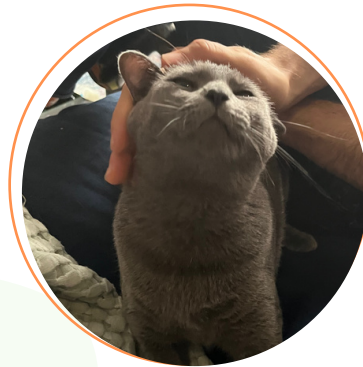
- Yes! We welcome pet parents as fosters.
- The risk to your own pets is minimal if they are vaccinated and in good health.

How long do animals stay in foster care?

- The time for each animal varies depending on their needs.
- We ask for at least a 6 week commitment.
- We discuss each case with potential fosters to make sure it is a good fit.

What expenses are involved?

- Fosters provide housing, food, litter, socialization, and lots of love!
- We provide medical care.



What support/training will I receive?

- You will be connected with an experienced volunteer who will provide guidance and support.
